2. The eligibility criteria for the above Master's Programme are as under:
Eligibility Criteria

- A female applicant (Ewha is not a co-ed university).
- Be preferably under 40 years.
- Having Tuberculosis or any kind of contagious disease is regarded as a disqualifying condition for participation in this program.
- A citizen of the country which has a cooperative relationship with KOICA.
- A government/municipality official or as researcher / an instructor working in any Govt. institute with a Bachelor's degree or higher.
- Nominated by the their respective Government.
- Sufficient command of both spoken & written English.
- Have not participated in KOICA's scholarship program or any of the Korean government's scholarship program before (Master's degree program).

Objectives

- Provide high quality education for women professionals with theoretical and practical skills and knowledge of development to enhance gender equality and empowerment of women in developing countries.
- Develop leadership capacity of women officials in public sector so that they can play key roles in the healthcare system of their countries.
- Share Korea's development experience which can be applied not only to ensure an efficient public health sector but also to improve the conditions of people in the participants' countries.

Nomination of suitable candidates fulfilling the laid-down eligibility criteria (with all the required documents of check list & eligibility criteria as mentioned above) prescribed by the sponsoring agency duly approved by the competent authority along with the documents may kindly be forwarded to this Division by **April 3, 2015** positively.
