Eligibility Criteria.

- Be a health official of medical, nursing or public health background with at least 2 (two) years Experience in the treatment and care for PLHA and well conversant on the HIV/AIDS program of own country.
- Expecting to continue working in the current services where knowledge acquired from the training will be used.
- Age between 27 to 50 years old.
- Proficient in both spoken and written English.
- In good health.

Objectives

- To understand principles and concepts of Antiretroviral Treatment (ART) management and long-term adherence to ART.
- To understand how the ART Program can be sustained by including in the Universal Health Coverage scheme.
- Be able to develop strategies and methodology in implementing ART programme including monitoring and evaluation.
- Be able to apply knowledge and skill gained to the case of their respective countries.




