2. The eligibility criteria for the above Master's Programme are as under:

Eligibility Criteria


- Bachelor's and/or a higher degree in Engineering (CHEM, ME, EE, and BT) from an accredited institution (CHEM: Chemical Engineering, ME: Mechanical Engineering, EE: Environmental Engineering, and BT: Biotechnology)
- Be Government Officers (BS-17 and above) only and nominated by respective Federal Government or Provincial Department having a minimum 2 years of experience in related field
- Have a good command of both spoken and written English in order to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and theses in English.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally. Pregnancy, HIV / AIDS, tuberculosis or any kinds of contagious disease are regarded as a disqualifying condition for the program.  
\* Pregnancy is regarded as a disqualifying condition to participate in this program.
- Having Tuberculosis or any kind of contagious disease is regarded as a disqualifying condition to participate in this program.
- Not be a person who has withdrawn from KOICA's scholarship program.  
\* Person belonging to the institution in which candidates submitted false documents and returned to his / her country arbitrarily in the middle of SP program cannot apply.
- Be under age 40 as of February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018

Objective:

Specifically designed for government officials from developing countries, the MChET program aims to contribute to economic development of these countries by

- Nurturing human resources capable of helping promote Chemical and Environmental Engineering, development cooperation, and adaptation of global climate change with Convergence Technology;
- Strengthening capabilities of government officials who are engaging in sustainable environmental development policy;
- Building human networks between and among the trainees and officials from relevant agencies and organizations and raising their understanding of how important the economic and cultural cooperation between countries.
- Offering them opportunities to learn chemical and environmental engineering for the purpose of promoting economic development and welfare in their countries.
- Assisting them to prepare and write a Master thesis on a subject related to chemical, energy and environmental problems.

Nomination of suitable candidates fulfilling the laid-down eligibility criteria (with all the required documents of check list & eligibility criteria as mentioned above) prescribed by the sponsoring agency duly approved by the competent authority along with the documents may kindly be forwarded to this Division by the close of business hours (4 PM) on 20<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 (Tuesday) positively.



\* Important Notes for All Applicants:

- i. All forms should be typed in English and all the supporting documents should be in English. Documents in any other language should be accompanied by a notarized English translation.
- ii. Original documents should be submitted. (If it is unavailable, the originating institution must authorize copies before they are submitted.)
- iii. If any of the submitted materials contain false information, admission will be rescinded.
- iv. Applicants whose forms and supporting documents are incomplete or unsatisfactory will be disqualified from the admission process.
- v. Applicants should take full responsibility for any disadvantage due to the mistakes or omissions on the application.
