The undersigned is directed to inform that Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) Islamabad office has invited **15 nominations** for the above mentioned **fully funded** training course scheduled to be held from 18-31 March, 2018 in Seoul, Korea. 2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Be Government officers (BS-17 and above), nominated by the relevant Federal Ministry/Provincial Department who have specialized knowledge of economic development.
- Be in good health both physically and mentally, to undergo the course.
- Have not participated in the same or similar KOICA fellowship programme in the past 3 years – unless otherwise specified.
- Have at least 5 years of experience working at the field of economy and / or relevant departments.
- Under 45 years of age and head of his department or section
- Sufficient proficiency in written and spoken English to actively participate in seminars and write an Action Plan

Objectives

- To establish economic development strategies through understanding of the economic development of Korea and policy.
- To design financing policy to alleviate regional polarization and to support marginalized class of people in Pakistan.
- To exchange views on urgent issues addressed at international seminars related to economic development strategy.
- To strengthen future cooperation in the economic development between Pakistan and Korea.




