



National Conference on Internal Security, Peace and Sustainable Development



Ministry of Planning, Development and Reform and Ministry of Interior co-organized a One-day National Conference on Internal Security, Peace and Sustainable Development at Pakistan Planning and Management Institute, Islamabad. The aim of the conference was to highlight a comprehensive policy framework to deal with all key aspects of National Security.
